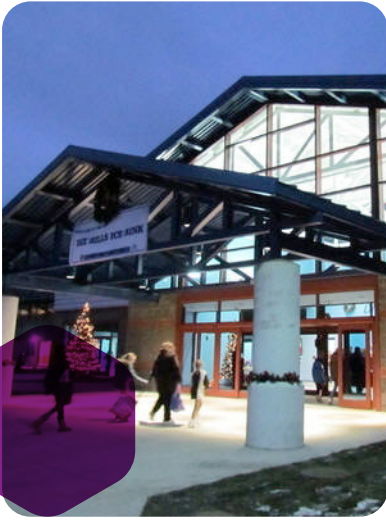
## Pin Trading + Team Pins

Included in each team's registration, each player will receive (before the start of the tournament) 2 logo pins of their team and a badge and lanyard on which to place the different pins the player has traded for with other teams. Coaches will also be provided a set number of extra team pins to be distributed at their discretion.
